Message from the President - 1/23/17

We hope you all enjoyed your Winter Break and are having an amazing 2017 so far. 2nd Quarter has just ended and we are moving right along to Quarter 3. The PTO has been very busy the past couple months and we wanted to highlight some of key points since school started.

1st grade field trip grant: The PTO approved a grant of \$325 to lower the "out of pocket" costs of the 1st graders who wanted to go on the field trip to Port Discovery.

Author Visit – 4th Grade: On January 24, the 4th graders will have a chance to listen to a local author named – Fred Bowen. He will explain how his love for life inspired him to put it in writing. Each 4th grader will receive a FREE book during this visit.

Author Visit - (2 assemblies): On January 26, the school will be split up between 2 assemblies to listen to a wellknown and famous local author named Barry Louis Polisar who loves to sing his books to the students. The cost of having this author come to the school would have cost over \$1,500.00 but through grants offered by the author we were able to pay \$320 for him to come out and speak to all of the students at Montpelier. Books and CD's will be on sale prior to this event and will be signed by the author.

Author Visit - (2 assemblies): On February 15, the school will have a chance to hear all about black history through books. A local author by the name of Frantz Derenoncourt, Jr. and he has spent much of his adult life speaking to children of all nationalities about history and how it became.

Kaboom Playground Grant: Montpelier Elementary PTO applied for a grant for new playground equipment. This equipment will replace all older outdated equipment and the students would be the designers. We have passed the first round of the grant process and are now in contention of getting approved. Before the build date we would need to come up with 10% of the cost, which comes to \$8,500.00. We are working with local community businesses and organizations but may have to do some fundraisers to help with this effort to. To get this done, we would need lot of help from the community so any help would be greatly appreciated. .

Feed the Children Grant: During this past summer, we applied for a grant for school supplies and furniture. We were finally approved and received several filing cabinets, chairs, school supplies for the students and even some supplies for the teachers. The items were located in PA, so we had to ship them to our location but everyone was delighted.
